The kick-off meeting of the Net age project ("Promote regional social development encouraging NETWORKING of relevant public- volunteering stakeholders to boost innovation in the delivering social-health-care services for AGEing people"), funded within the IPA Adriatic Cooperation Programme will be held in Split, Croatia from 21-22 March 2013.

Through the cooperation of 13 partners from 6 countries included in the program area, the project aims at strengthening the sustainable development capabilities of the Adriatic regions involved and the demographic process focusing on innovative social and health services to favor active ageing and independent living of elderly.

NET-Age directly addresses the follow shared main problems related to the coordination, quality and effectiveness of policies and services target to elderly people:

- 1) Lack of coordination among public & volunteering stakeholders
- 2) Lack of adequately trained civil servants & members of volunteering associations
- 3) Lack of information and data on social welfare, health care and elderly assistance, on stakeholders involved in the elderly home care services, on services delivered by public-private actors to elderly.
